On their website, they write: RAF Lakenheath is in reality USAF Lakenheath and is the largest US airbase in Europe. It is assigned to United States Air Forces in Europe and Africa. Its Air Force units maintain combat-ready wings that are pledged to NATO, which plans, conducts, controls, coordinates and supports air and space operations in Europe, parts of Asia and all of Africa with the exception of Egypt. USAF Lakenheath is a threat to

us all with its conventional weapons that have been deployed in Kuwait, Iraq, Afghanistan, Serbia, Libya, Syria, the Middle East and East Africa. But with nuclear weapons coming back it becomes even more dangerous.

Iran could have an operational nuclear weapon within "weeks, maybe days," a former Israeli ambassador to the U.S. said, as Israel closely watches whether Iran could quickly pivot and produce such a weapon before next month's change of administration in Washington. Michael Oren told Newsweek that Iran will be dreading President-elect Donald Trump's return to the White House, adding that Tehran wouldn't "dare" to make the final push toward an operational nuclear weapon once the new administration takes over.

The world has never been in a more dangerous state, the head of Mi6 warned earlier this month. Sir Richard Moore, Britain's spy chief, is not the first world leader to be alarmed at the dangers posed by the war in Ukraine, the rhetoric from Vladimir Putin and the maverick North Korea's testing of missiles. Admiral Sir Tony Radakin, Chief of Defence Staff, warned this week that the world is "at the dawn of a third nuclear age" at the annual Rusi lecture, in which he pointed to the combined threats we face from four adversaries in particular: Russia, North Korea, Iran and China. It was the inclusion of China that attracted particular attention, however. The threat of a catastrophic nuclear conflict never truly subsided. And now, fears are intensifying once again amid a new arms race for tactical nuclear weapons, one being led by a Russian state already at war in Europe. *Telegraph 17th Dec 2024* https://tinyurl.com/4mjdxw6h

This is the moment a swarm of drones fly over an American air base which is set to become home to US nuclear weapons. The footage obtained by MailOnline features what is suspected to be drones, brazenly flying with bright lights, in the early evening darkness above RAF Lakenheath, Suffolk. Reports about American nuclear weapons being deployed to the base for the first time since the Cold War have heightened fears that Russia could be behind the drone activity. Hitting Iran now could halt its nuclear plan. Tehran is exposed and may rush to get the bomb. The West should give it a short, sharp shock. Rafael Grossi, director of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), said Iran was "dramatically" accelerating uranium enrichment to 60%, a short hop away from the 90% needed for weapons grade. There was no civilian programme that could justify such a move. Indeed, no other country has done so without in the end producing nuclear weapons. The IAEA calculates that Iran already has enough 60% purity stock to upgrade into four nuclear weapons. The collapse of Iran's proxies, the flimsy nature of Russian support for the regime, the erosion of Iranian air defence and the imminent arrival in the White House of Donald Trump point to the possibility of a galloping nuclearisation by the regime and a pre-emptive strike by Israel. The Submarine Delivery Agency (SDA) has detailed progress in its Dreadnought and SSN-A submarine programmes. HMS Dreadnought, the first of the next-generation strategic deterrent submarines, reached a key milestone with the completion of its largest structural segment, referred to as a "mega unit." ... The SDA emphasised this achievement as evidence of "the ongoing advancement of the Dreadnought programme." The agency stated that "robust performance metrics" have driven improvements, noting that collaboration with BAE Systems continues to stabilise the programme, mitigate risks, and capitalise on opportunities.

NUCLEAR POWER

Sizewell C has won a legal battle against activists seeking for the Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR) to withdraw the nuclear power plant's nuclear site licence (NSL). The NSL was granted in April 2024. The decision was made following an assessment of Sizewell C Ltd's nuclear site licence application. ONR concluded that the application met the requirements set out in the regulatory guidance. Over the past month there has been much activity at RAF Fairford in Gloucestershire which looks set to become a hub for long-range US spy drones like the Global Hawk and Reaper. These drones carry out secretive surveillance missions over Gaza and across the Middle East.
