

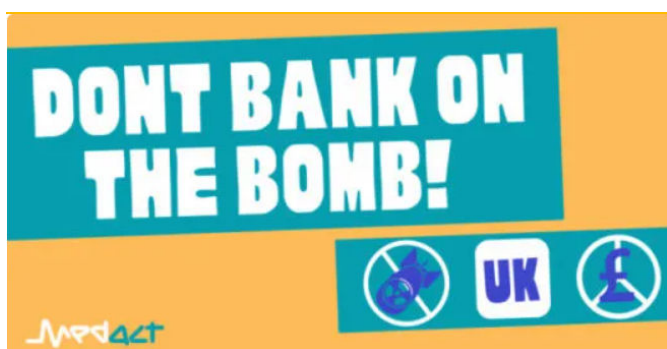

BITS FROM ABROAD

At the UK-France Summit in July 2025, Prime Minister Keir Starmer and President Emmanuel Macron affirmed their commitment to strengthening the UK-France nuclear relationship. They signed the Northwood Declaration, which established the UK-France Nuclear Steering Group in order to provide political direction and coordinate bilateral work across nuclear policy, capability and operations. On 10 December, the Nuclear Steering Group met for the first time in Paris ... They discussed their approach to strengthening deterrence in Europe and confirmed their ambition for bilateral co-operation on nuclear deterrence. They also observed Operation POKER which was the first time foreign officials were given access to this demonstration of France's strategic nuclear airborne component.

A massive \$264 million plan to overhaul a Royal Air Force base in the English countryside includes knocking down at least half a dozen existing buildings, setting up secure intelligence facilities, protecting the surrounding area against enemy electronic pulse attacks, and sending over 200 American personnel, according to Pentagon funding proposals. It represents confirmation that American nuclear weapons will return to Britain for the first time since President Barack Obama withdrew them 17 years ago.

However, despite widespread speculation that U.S. nuclear weapons have already arrived in the U.K, the documents indicate it will not happen for several years. The idea that they had already been sent gained steam on July 17 when a massive U.S. Air Force C-17 Globemaster III arrived at RAF Lakenheath in Suffolk.

The fragile global legal framework for nuclear weapons control faces further setbacks in 2026, eroding guardrails to avoid a nuclear crisis. The first half of the year will see two key events: the US-Russia bilateral treaty, New START, expires on February 5, and in April, New York hosts the Review Conference (RevCon) of the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT) -- the cornerstone of global nuclear security frameworks. The RevCon, held every four to five years, is meant to keep the NPT alive. But during the last two sessions, the 191 signatory states failed to agree on a final document, and experts expect the same outcome in April.

Work has been carried out on land opposite the Atomic Weapons Establishment's (AWE) Aldermaston campus despite a temporary stop notice, West Berkshire Council said. Hundreds of people have signed an online petition that states the work has left others feeling "unsafe, anxious and unprotected", according to the Local Democracy Reporting Service.

Work is underway to design an emergency planning zone as plans progress for Rosyth to be the temporary repair base for the UK's new fleet of nuclear deterrent submarines. Grant Reekie, head of radioactive waste and health physics at Babcock International in Rosyth, told councillors: "The next generation of submarines is going to be launched from Barrow towards the end of this decade. The intention is these will be maintained at the HM Naval base Clyde however the Clyde facilities will not be available until mid-2030s."

Bill Kidd MSP: Thanks to the publication of a new Nuclear Education Trust report, **Stepping Back From The Brink: The Myths Of Tactical Nuclear Weapons And Limited Nuclear War**, we have additional detail on how the Ministry of Defence is to spend billions reintroducing tactical nuclear weapons into the RAF. We also know that these are weapons the RAF will not own or control. Re-nuclearising the RAF requires much more than the purchase of an additional squadron of F-35A jets at around £1 billion. Creating the logistical and command and control infrastructure will be 10 times the cost of just the aircraft.
